MODALITIES



Bumping

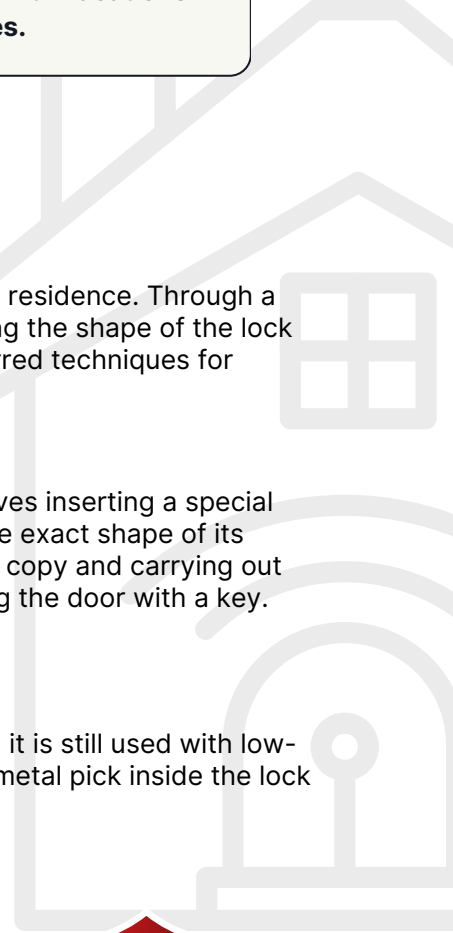
It involves using a master key to access the residence. Through a series of small blows, this key ends up taking the shape of the lock and opening the door. It is one of the preferred techniques for criminals due to its quick execution.

Impresioning

Although much more sophisticated, it involves inserting a special aluminum sheet inside the lock to obtain the exact shape of its interior. This serves as a mold for making a copy and carrying out the theft in the residence by simply opening the door with a key.

Ganzúa

While it is one of the most classic methods, it is still used with low-security locks. It involves inserting a small metal pick inside the lock to align all the pins until it yields.



RECOMMENDATIONS



- ✓ Check the condition of the locks, close doors and windows securely.
- ✓ Before leaving on a trip, check the security of your home, test the connection of your alarm systems.
- ✓ Close the main water and gas valves, disconnect appliances that may interfere with the sensitivity of your alarm.
