RECOMMENDATIONS

Despite the festive atmosphere, always respect traffic regulations and cross on pedestrian paths to avoid accidents.



Beware of reckless drivers, especially late at night.



Always take care and keep your personal belongings in sight, as criminals take advantage of crowded areas to camouflage themselves and commit thefts.



Avoid traveling in poorly lit areas.



If you are going out for night activities, try not to take transportation alone.



If you go to parties, never lose sight of your drink; criminals can take advantage of an oversight and adulterate it.



Arrange meeting points with the people you are going out with. Due to the large crowds, it is easy to get lost.



If you use digital transportation platforms, activate the security PIN option. By using this code you ensure that the vehicle you ordered through the application is the same one in which you are traveling.



When attending an event, identify the number and type of access and exit routes for participants. This way you will be prepared for an emergency.
